MEMBERSHIP

Increase net membership:

THE ROTARY FOUNDATION

- Annual Fund Goal of \$210,000

- Goal of \$50,000 for PolioPlus from the clubs.

- Assist all Clubs in using DaCdb especially in accuracy/completeness of membership information.
- Achieve 75% Club participation in Rotary Club Central use.
- Achieve 85% Club participation in using RI Direct with DaCdb to save time and improve accuracy.
- Have 100% of Clubs participate in June 20, 2015 District Training Assembly
- Offer Instruction in using social media effectively

YOUTH SERVICE

Ryla	Each Club supports Ryla by sponsoring a student from the community and/or providing financing (\$250) for a student outside the community; 25 Rotarian volunteers; 65 students in attendance.
Interact	Establish 5 new Interact clubs (Middle School or High School)
